INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE RE 3, 4 OR OTH DISCHARGE WAIVER REQUEST

1) NMSDF REG 600-10 para 2-3 states:

c. Those dropped from the rolls or released from any Uniformed Service of the United States under other than honorable conditions, for unsatisfactory service, by resignation in lieu of court martial, by elimination for any form of corrective or disciplinary action, for the good of the service, or for presenting a security risk.

d. Persons with former military service who were discharged with a reenlistment code of RE-4 (except for retirement). Those with an RE-3 code will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

2) The New Mexico State Defense Force Selection Board can waiver RE-3 Coded applicants on a case by case basis. If you think your case is waiverable, include this document with your application packet. RE4 for retirement DO NOT fill out this form

3) Only the Assistant Adjutant General, SDF Div. can waiver an RE-4 or Other than Honorable discharge requirements. If an applicant chooses, they can submit a Waiver request sealed in an envelope directed to the AAG-SDF, and to be opened only by him. The Selection Board will review all other documents, and forward application packet to AAG-SDF on a rejection pending basis.

4) Filling out the form:

a) Print or type name on the first line.

b) CONDITION – circle all that apply.

c) REASON: State accurate succinct reason. If for medical reasons, state only “MEDICAL”, and Board will likely waiver.

d) Signature; must be signed. Typed signatures are not acceptable

e) Last federal or current SDF rank. SSN

f) DO NOT FILL OUT BELOW THIS LINE. Submit 1st page form only.

5) Selection Board President will fill out on Board waived RE3 applicants. The AAG-SDF will fill out on all others.

a) circle APPROVE or DECLINE as appropriate. Board President only does so on RE3's that are approved by the Selection Board..

b) Board President signs, prints name and dates if Board approved, then writes “FOR” in front of AAG-SDF tag line.

c) Otherwise, AAG-SDF will approve or decline, then sign.

6) Copy will be sent to Requester, and original inserted in their file
